8.	Niersteiner Gutes Domtal 2007/08 - Franz Reh, Germany Both floral and leafy, with a fresh sweet fullness. (4) 9%vol	Btl	£12.50

13.	Torres Viña Esmeralda - 2008/09 : Penedes, Spain Fragrant, delicately floral, lightly spicy and with just a hint of sweetness. A success since its creation, Esmeralda may well be Spain's most famous white wine. (3) 11.5%vol	Btl	£16.95

| 23. | San Alessandro Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2008/09 - Italy
A touch of cherries and light herbal notes complement the soft texture and easy style. (C) 14%vol | Btl | £12.95 |
| 24. | La Masquerade Merlot 2006/07 - Pays d'Oc, France
Soft and plummy red wine from the deep South of France. Luscious ripe fruit is backed by firm tannins and a light oaky touch for added depth. (C) 14.5%vol | Btl | £14.95 |
| 25. | Crystal Brook Shiraz 2008/09 - S.E Australia
Immediately-pleasing, spicy-fruity, even neatly polished. Plenty of sweet blackberry and prunes fruit backed with a velvet overcoat. (C) 13.5%vol | Btl | £15.50 |
| 26. | Brown Brothers Tarrango 2008/09 - Victoria, Australia

28. **Côtes du Rhône Prestige 2005/0628.** - Louis Mousset, France Btl £16.95
France A thoroughly amiable southern Rhône of warmth and ripeness, with plenty of red berry fruits and a fine tannin structure to create good all-round balance. (C) 13.5%vol
29. **Mazuelo Rioja Crianza 2005/06** - Azabache, Spain Btl £17.50
Spain Instantly attractive combination of vital strawberry fruit and soft oak flavours that is the hallmark of Rioja - and its universal appeal. Very satisfying. (C) 13.5%vol
30. **Valpolicella Classico Superiore 2008/09** - Tommasi, Italy Btl £19.50
Dark cherry character and nice meaty flavours. Perfectly full-bodied and balanced wine from this dynamic Veneto producer. (C) 12%vol
31. **Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2006/07** - Domaine Faiveley, France £22.50
Young domaine-bottled Burgundy from a great house. Fresh and genuine Pinot Noir character - and a touch of seriousness too. (B) 12.5%vol

32. **Brown Brothers Orange Muscat & Flora 2008/09** - Victoria, Australia Hlf Btl £14.25
Intense gold luminescence to the eye. This wine has startlingly lovely pure grape sweetness of Muscat, with a flash of orange. Fine, smooth and utterly luscious. (8) 9.5%vol
